If your topic doesn't fit within this theme, you are still welcome to submit your paper. Presentations reflecting practice issues are also welcome.

Deadline for submissions: Thursday 8 August 2024, at 12 noon (BST).

Before submitting your paper, please read the following.

- If your application is successful selected entrants will be required to produce a physical poster to be displayed on poster boards at the UKCP Conference on Friday 22 and Saturday 23 November 2024 (details of the required poster size will be confirmed to selected presenters in their confirmation emails).
- Posters can be displayed across both days at conference.
- Entrants will be notified week commencing **Monday 16 September** if their application has been successful.

Where will my poster be displayed?

Posters will be displayed in a dedicated area in the exhibition hall on traditional poster boards, providing a space where you can share and discuss your project with your peers.



- Details of the required poster size will be confirmed to the selected presenters in their confirmation emails.
- It is not permitted to include the UKCP logo on the physical poster. Any physical poster containing the UKCP logo will not be displayed.
- Posters can only be fixed by Velcro; this will be provided at the conference.
- Posters should be printed and brought to Conference by presenters.
- Details on set up and taking down will be advised to those selected prior to the Conference.
